

Social media netiquette

The eTransFair project team promotes and supports an open dialogue. Therefore, we are looking forward to your comments and participation in discussions. To guarantee respectful communication, the following rules apply to all comments posted on the social media channels of the eTransFair website and social media channels.

- Users are personally responsible for their posts.
- There is no tolerance for contributions that
 - contain sexist, racist or discriminatory content;
 - contain personal attacks or libellous contents;
 - are abusive, defamatory or unlawful;
 - contain threats or incitement to violence;
 - are pornographic;
 - are aimed at bad-mouthing a person, a group of persons, a department (sub-unit) or a degree programme;
 - serve the sole purpose of advertising any service or company or are of a promotional nature.
- Respectful communication is important to us. Be mindful of your wording and do not use abusive language.
- Repeated posting of identical or similar contributions disturbs the discussion. Contributions will
 not appear any sooner. Therefore, please refrain from spamming or flooding a contribution with
 a high amount of comments.
- The comments are moderated. Contributions can be deleted, shortened or hidden. There is no legal claim on publication.
- Users who repeatedly violate the rules of the netiquette will be blocked.
- If contributions violate existing law or infringe the rights of third parties, users are liable to prosecution.
